

RESOLUTION

TEACHER PREPARATION FOR PARENT/FAMILY INVOLVEMENT

- Whereas, The PTA mission is three-fold: to support and speak on behalf of children and youth in the schools, in the community, and before governmental agencies and other organizations that make decisions affecting children; to assist parents in developing the skills they need to raise and protect their children; and to encourage parent and public involvement in the public schools of this nation.
- Whereas, Studies indicate parent/family involvement in education increases a child's chances for success in school; and
- Whereas, Undergraduate teacher training for effectively involving and including parents/families in education is not widely offered by colleges and universities throughout this state; and
- Whereas, State teacher certification agencies do not require such training for the issuance of a teaching certificate nor for the renewal of a certificate; therefore, be it
- Resolved, That the Delaware PTA support a requirement in teacher preparation for parent/family involvement through the accreditation of teacher education programs by the National and State Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education; and be it further
- Resolved, That the Delaware PTA will work with the State's universities and colleges of education to develop and require specific training to effectively involve and include parents/families in the educational process of their children; and be it further
- Resolved, That the Delaware PTA will urge the State teacher certification agencies to require parent/family involvement training for teacher certification and recertification.
